EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

These gifts of \$75,000 each from the ECSU Foundation, Inc. are made possible by a grant from United Illuminating to support the services of the Institute for Sustainable Energy in meeting its objectives.

Previous installment gifts of \$75,000 each were accepted by the Board on behalf of ECSU in November 2002 and January 2003. These final two installments complete the total gift of \$300,000 for calendar year 2002.

The gifts comply with the Board's policy requiring that cash gifts of more than \$25,000 be brought to the Trustees for acceptance.

Accept the two gifts of \$75,000 each on behalf of Eastern Connecticut State University.
