WHEREAS, The President of Southern Connecticut State University has evaluated the work of the Center and has recommended that it not be continued, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Trustees for the Connecticut State University System hereby dissolves the Business Resource Center, effective December 31, 2006.

BACKGROUND

The Business Resource Center was established by BR 01-34 to improve the quality of business education for SCSU students by engaging them in “real world” experience, facilitating research activity for faculty and students and providing expertise to Connecticut organizations and individuals.

ANALYSIS

Due to lack of activity, President Norton has recommended the discontinuation of the Center until such time as a plan of activity and funding has been developed.
