WHEREAS, The President of Southern Connecticut State University has evaluated the work of the Center and has recommended that it not be continued, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Trustees for the Connecticut State University System hereby dissolves the Global Center, effective December 31, 2006.

BACKGROUND

The Global Center was established by BR 01-35 to serve as an educational resource, facilitating global research activity for students and faculty; providing international expertise to Connecticut organizations and implementing global enrichment opportunities for the university community and the community at-large.

ANALYSIS

Due to lack of activity, President Norton has recommended the discontinuation of the Center until such time as a plan of activity and funding has been developed.
