THE USE OF PLANT FUNDS BY SOUTHERN
CONNECTICUT STATE UNIVERSITY FOR THE DESIGN OF
A NEW STUDENT PARKING GARAGE

December 8, 2006

- WHEREAS, Southern Connecticut State University's 2004 Master Plan recommends the development of four new parking garages to meet the current and projected needs of the University, and
- WHEREAS, SCSU proposes to construct a new 1,200-car student parking garage on the site of Lot 7 adjacent to Moore Field House and the new Energy Center, and
- WHEREAS, Construction funds for this project will be provided through the next CHEFA bond sale, which is anticipated to take place in Fall 2007, therefore be it
- RESOLVED, That Southern Connecticut State University is authorized to use up to \$2,200,000 in plant funds to provide for the design phase of a new student parking garage to be located on Lot 7, in New Haven, Connecticut.
