WHEREAS, The Center for Caribbean and Latin American Studies at Central Connecticut State University was established through BR#95-73 and last authorized via BR# 07-05; and

WHEREAS, The President of Central Connecticut State University has evaluated the work of the Center and has recommended a name change and modification to the mission as outlined below:

“The Latin American, Latino and Caribbean Center, in keeping with the distinctive mission; values; and traditions at Central Connecticut State University, promotes the understanding and the appreciation of the historical, social, and cultural life of Latin American and Caribbean societies and of Latinos in the United States through education, community events, study abroad, international exchange, community outreach and research. Because of the importance of the Latino community as one of the largest minority groups in the United States, the Center plays an important role in providing educational opportunities to Latino students, promoting Latino culture, and in maintaining a harmonious relationship with non-Latino cultures. The Center’s mission is consistent with the University’s mission of fostering diversity and global awareness”
Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Trustees for the Connecticut State University System accepts the recommendation of the President and Chancellor to accept the change in name to the Latin American, Latino and Caribbean Center along with the modification of the mission, and be it further

RESOLVED, The President of Central should submit a report to the Chancellor of the Connecticut State University System evaluating the performance of the Center and recommending continuance or discontinuance by September 1, 2010, as originally scheduled, and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Latin American, Latino and Caribbean Center at Central Connecticut State University has a sunset date of December 31, 2010, unless the Board of Trustees acts to the contrary.
