RESOLUTION

concerning

Board Action on the Proposed Financial Adjustment
for Unclassified Employees

December 7, 1973

- WHEREAS, The Commission on Higher Education has asked that the Board of Trustees defer its action to provide salary adjustments for unclassified employees, and
- WHEREAS, The Trustees have already delayed such action 57 days beyond the 60 days required for the CHE reactions on the proposed salary adjustment, and
- WHEREAS, The Trustees are deeply concerned lest the extended delay further undermine the morale of its unclassified employees, be it
- RESOLVED, That, nevertheless, the Trustees, at the specific urging of CHE, reluctantly defer the action on salary adjustments planned for the December Trustees' meeting, and be it further
- RESOLVED, That the Trustees will take action at their meeting in January 1974 to provide salary adjustments and that the Chairman of the Board shall so inform the Commission in writing, and be it further
- RESOLVED, That the Board's Committee on Personnel shall study any recommendations concerning salaries that may be made by the Commission on Higher Education in the interim and report its findings and recommendations to the Board at its January meeting.
