Whereas, The Northern Perimeter Road, presently under construction at Central Connecticut State College, crosses over a sewer line of the City of New Britain, and

Whereas, Said crossover impairs the City's access to the area for the purpose of modernizing the sewer line and for future maintenance thereof, and

Whereas, The granting to the City of an easement through Central Connecticut State College property would provide greater accessibility to the sewer line area, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Trustees for the State Colleges authorizes the State Department of Public Works, and/or the Office of the Attorney General acting in its behalf, to grant to the City of New Britain an easement of an additional fifteen feet on the west side of the present easement from the junction of the Kilbourne Avenue easement northward to Pape Road, with the provision that Central Connecticut State College shall retain full access to the surface use thereof.
