

Extension of retirement - George Sharp

Our request to extend the retirement of George Sharp is necessary because of Dr. Sharp's assignment for the coming semester.

First, he will be teaching sections of the culminating seminar course in the Masters program. Without Dr. Sharp's participation in this course there is not sufficient expertise to permit students to complete their master's degrees.

The second part of Dr. Sharp's assignment will be the supervision of 4 student teachers. To change supervisors in the middle of the term would be extremely harmful to the programs of the students involved and to our relationship with public school systems.
