RESOLUTION

concerning

FACULTY EXCHANGE

EASTERN CONNECTICUT STATE COLLEGE

March 12, 1976

WHEREAS, An exchange of teachers with foreign institutions provides enrichment of educational programs, be it

RESOLVED, That under the authority granted by Sections 10-27, 10-109b and 10-329a of the General Statutes, the Board of Trustees for the State Colleges of Connecticut authorizes an exchange of teachers involving Dr. Barry Wulff, Assistant Professor at Eastern Connecticut State College and Mr. Raymond Baynes in the Vancouver Community College, Langara, Vancouver, British Columbia, the said exchange to be subject to the following conditions:

- A. The salary of Dr. Wulff shall be paid by Eastern Connecticut State College.
- B. The salary of Mr. Baynes shall be paid by Vancouver Community College.
- C. Transportation, lodging, and other personal expense incurred in the exchange will be fully assumed by the individuals involved.
- D. Mr. Baynes will report to the Chairman of the Department of Biology of Eastern Connecticut State College at the beginning of the fall semester and will assume Dr. Wulff's teaching assignments.
Dr. Wulff will assume Mr. Baynes' teaching assignments in the area of biology at Vancouver Community College.
- E. The exchange shall be for the academic year 1976-77.
