SALARY SCHEDULE FOR PART-TIME LECTURERS

December 8, 1978

RESOLVED, That the portion of Board Resolution #68-34, dated July 12, 1968, establishing a salary schedule for part-time lecturers who are not members of the permanent faculty of the Connecticut State Colleges, be rescinded to provide for the following salary schedule, effective with the Fall Semester, 1979:

Lecturer I - \$267.50 per semester hour

Lecturer II - \$321.00 per semester hour

and be it

RESOLVED, That the salary for Special Lecturers who are part-time teachers and who are not members of the permanent faculty of the Connecticut State Colleges be continued as negotiable at a rate of not more than \$500 per semester hour as provided in Board Resolution #78-21, dated March 10, 1978.

APPOINTMENT AND APPROVAL FOR PAYMENT OF PART-TIME EVENING COLLEGE
AND SUMMER SESSION LECTURERS WHO ARE NOT PERMANENT MEMBERS OF THE
FACULTY OF THE COLLEGES

March 10, 1978

WHEREAS, The Board of Trustees on September 16, 1974 by Resolution #74-66 established that decisions concerning unclassified personnel appointed within budgeted appropriations are the sole responsibility of the Board and all decisions effecting these positions shall be made by the Board of Trustees for State Colleges, and

WHEREAS, The Board of Trustees on July 12, 1968 by Resolution #68-34 established a salary schedule for part-time evening college and summer session lecturers who are not members of the permanent faculty, and

WHEREAS, The Board of Trustees has designated the Executive Director to act in its behalf, therefore, be it


RESOLVED, That each of the four State Colleges shall, prior to the start of each semester and each summer session, submit to the Board of Trustees a request specifying the maximum number of part-time lecturer positions the college will fill for that semester or summer session, and be it

RESOLVED, That once these requests are approved by the Board each college may submit to the Executive Director, or his designee, a roster of part-time lecturers to fill the established positions, and be it

RESOLVED, That the Executive Director, or his designee, review these rosters for conformance with established Board of Trustees' policy and if satisfied that they are consistent with those policies may approve said rosters for payment, and be it further

~~RESOLVED,~~ That the Board Resolution dated July 12, 1968, establishing a salary schedule for part-time evening college lecturers and summer session lecturers be amended to provide a salary of Special Lecturer at a negotiable rate of not more than \$500. per semester hour.

AUTHORIZING RESOLUTION

July 12, 1968

RESOLVED, (1) That the Board of Trustees approve to be effective September 1, 1968 the following salary schedule for part-time evening college and summer session lecturers who are not members of permanent faculty of the colleges:

Lecturer I	- \$250 per semester hour
Lecturer II	- \$300 per semester hour
Special Lecturer	- negotiable

(2) That the Board of Trustees approve to be effective beginning in the summer of 1969, the following salary schedule for permanent members of the college faculties who teach summer session courses; totaling six credit hours or the equivalent:

Professor	- \$2500
Associate Professor	- \$2150
Assistant Professor	- \$1765
Instructor	- \$1585
Assistant Instructor	- \$1280

and,

(3) That the Board of Trustees approve the following adjustment in tuition rates for part-time evening college and summer session courses effective September 1, 1968:

From \$20 to \$25 per semester hour for undergraduate students.
From \$20 to \$30 per semester hour for graduate students.

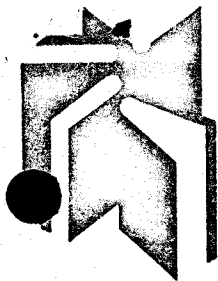

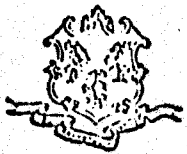
