STUDENTS' OPTIONAL SICKNESS INSURANCE

February 6, 1981

- WHEREAS, The Trustees desire to continue the optional Sickness Insurance Program for 1981-82 for students who pay General Fund tuition other than foreign students on temporary visas, and
- WHEREAS, The Aetna Life Insurance Company has indicated that benefits for this program can be increased in 1981-82, as shown in the attached schedule, with no increase in rates, therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, That the contract with the Aetna Life Insurance Company through Goodwin, Loomis, and Britton, Inc. for optional sickness insurance is approved for renewal for the year 1981-82 at a rate of \$36 per student and with increased benefits as shown in the attached schedule.
