WHEREAS, The Board of Trustees for State Colleges authorized the establishment of a Central Office Auxiliary Services Account to meet the cost of non-recurring major repairs to student residences, food service areas, and student centers, and

WHEREAS, On April 3, 1981, the Board of Trustees passed Board Resolution #81-58 authorizing the replacing of two roof areas at Fairfield Hall at Western Connecticut State College at an estimated cost of \$12,000, and

WHEREAS, Bids received indicate a cost well below the original estimate and also below the minimum cost required to qualify for funding from the Central Office Auxiliary Services Account, be it
