

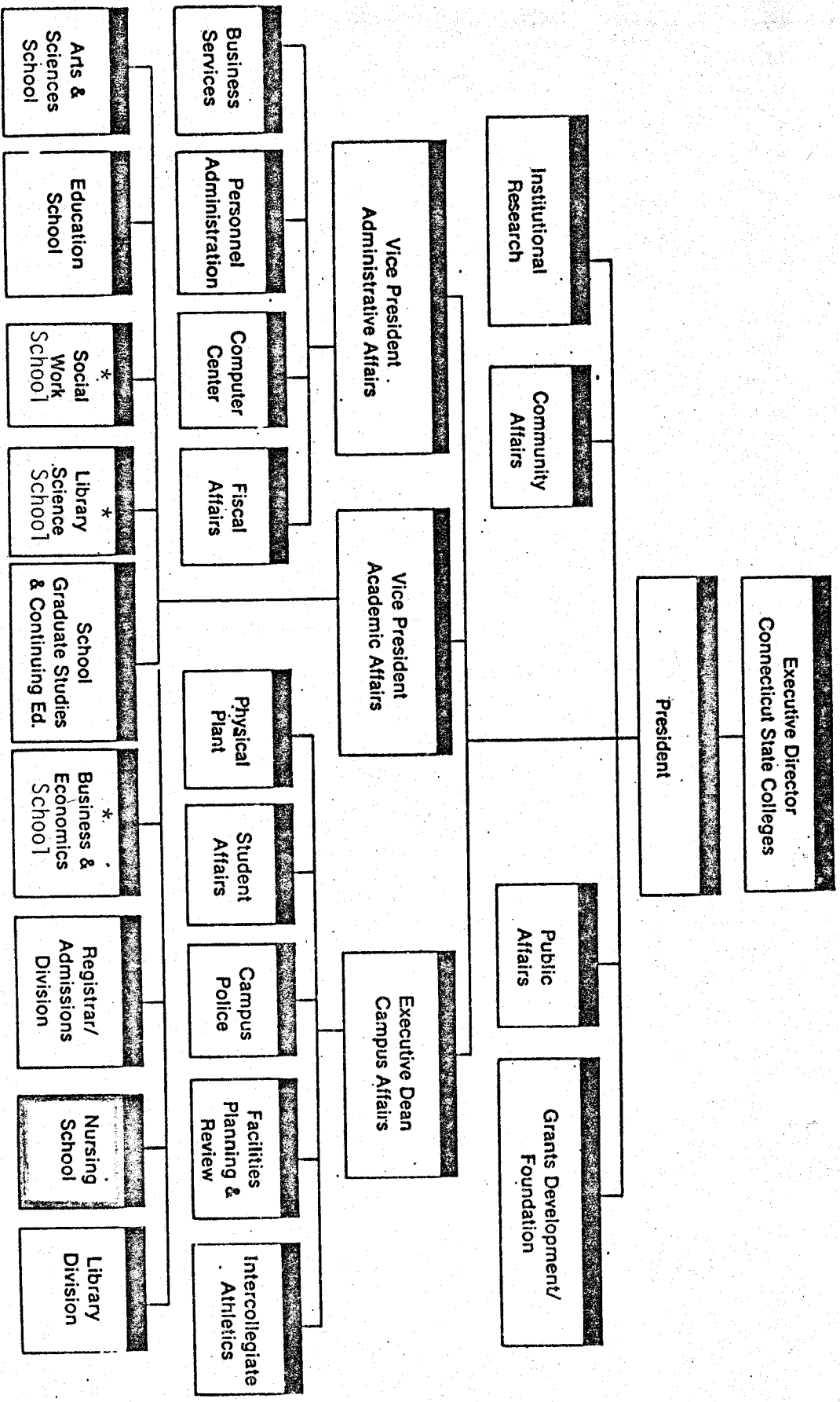
- WHEREAS, Southern Connecticut State College offers a fully accredited undergraduate program in Social Work and has received approval to begin a Master of Social Work program, and

**Creation of Schools and a Position of Dean**
