FEE SCHEDULE AND REFUND POLICY

December 3, 1982

WHEREAS, The Board of Trustees for the Connecticut State Colleges by Resolution #82-12, dated March 5, 1982, revised the Fee Schedule and Refund Policy effective for the Fall 1982 semester, and

WHEREAS, It has been determined that it would be advantageous to make certain changes in the fee schedule and refund policy of the Board of Trustees; namely, the establishing of May 1 as the due date for the Admission Binder, and a reduction in the length of the period of time over which refunds may be made, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Fee Schedule and Refund Policy adopted by the Board of Trustees for State Colleges in Resolution #82-12, dated March 5, 1982, shall be replaced by the attached Fee Schedule and Refund Policy, effective for the Fall 1983 semester, and be it

RESOLVED, That, under circumstances beyond the control of the student or in cases where attendance has been denied by the College, the President may authorize the refunding of fees otherwise designated as non-refundable, and be it

RESOLVED, That Board Resolution #82-86, dated July 23, 1982, is rescinded.

EXTENSION AND SUMMER COURSES


