POSITION SUMMARY:

Provides direct services and coordinates related program services for students participating in the Connecticut Collegiate Awareness and Preparation Program (CONNCAP). Working closely with school system and university personnel, identifies and recruits CONNCAP students; provides academic, career, personal and tutorial advising; designs, coordinates and implements program activities on-site, on-campus, and in the community.

POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES:

Assists in identifying eligible students and in promoting program

Builds community and school system support network

Coordinates on-site tutorial and enrichment programs, and CONNCAP on-campus summer program

Maintains records of activities

Acts as liaison between program, the school system, and the university

Performs other duties and responsibilities related to those enumerated above which do not alter the basic level of responsibility of the position
