RESOLUTION


concerning

STATE UNIVERSITY ASSISTANTS

NOVEMBER 6, 1987

- WHEREAS, There is reason to define more accurately the working status of State University Assistants, now, therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, That Board Resolution 87-52 is hereby rescinded, and be it further
- RESOLVED, That there shall continue to be a part-time employment category (19 hours or less per week) of State University Assistant, Unclassified, for persons employed in non-teaching capacities, and be it further
- RESOLVED, That State University Assistant's earnings shall not exceed \$1,500.00 per month or \$18,000 for a fiscal year, and be it further
- RESOLVED, That this employment category is separate from currently defined collective bargaining units as defined by the State Board of Labor Relations, and personnel included in this category are ineligible for negotiated fringe benefits.



APRIL 3, 1987

- WHEREAS, The intent of the Board's action in repealing Board Resolution #84-200 was to clarify the status of part-time State University positions; and
- WHEREAS, The Board of Trustees previously had established the part-time category and level of compensation for the position of State University Assistant; and
- WHEREAS, It is desirable to increase the compensation for this category of part-time employment; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED, That there continue to be a part-time employment category of State University Assistant for persons employed in non-teaching capacities and that the salary for State University Assistant be individually determined to a maximum of \$5,000.00 per semester; and be it further
- RESOLVED, That this employment category be excluded from collective bargaining units as defined by the State Board of Labor Relations and that persons employed under this category be ineligible for fringe benefits.
