
WHEREAS, The association of Leo Connellan with Connecticut State University has been beneficial to the students and reputation of Connecticut State University, and

WHEREAS, Continuation of a relationship is desirable, now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That, pursuant to the "Personnel Policies for Management Personnel and Confidential Professional Personnel" and BR#82-120, effective August 26, 1988, Leo Connellan is appointed Connecticut State University Poet-in-Residence at a biweekly salary rate of \$1,149.43 (annual \$30,000) until August 23, 1990, and be it further

RESOLVED, That Eastern Connecticut State University shall act as host campus on behalf of Connecticut State University for 1988-89. During his term of service Leo Connellan shall be entitled to all benefits as enumerated in the Board's "Personnel Policies for Management Personnel and Confidential Professional Personnel," except that, owing to the nature of the appointment, there shall be no expectation of renewal.



ESTABLISHMENT OF THE "IN RESIDENCE" TITLE

November 5, 1982

- WHEREAS, Persons of established reputation in their chosen fields such as writers, artists, poets, business executives, and others, can make significant contributions to the instructional programs of the Connecticut State Colleges by spending limited periods of time in residence on the campuses, and
- WHEREAS, There is a need for an appropriate title for the appointment of such outside persons, therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, That the title _____ in Residence (e.g., Writer in Residence, Executive in Residence, etc.) is established, and be it
- RESOLVED, That appointments to this title shall be essentially honorary in character although in appropriate situations compensation may be paid, and be it
- RESOLVED, That persons shall be appointed to such title only for specified limited terms and shall not be eligible for tenure or for any other privilege not authorized by the Board of Trustees, and be it
- RESOLVED, That approval of the appointments shall be by the Board of Trustees.
