RESOLUTION

concerning

AN INCREASE IN HOUSING FEES

December 1, 1989

- WHEREAS, Section 10a-99 of the General Statutes provides that the Board of Trustees for the Connecticut State University, subject to the approval of the Board of Governors for Higher Education, shall fix fees for such purposes as the Board of Trustees deems necessary, and
- WHEREAS, Revenue produced at current rates is not sufficient to cover escalating costs due to inflation and salary adjustments, therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, That Board Resolution #88-166 is rescinded, and be it
- RESOLVED, That, if the Board of Governors for Higher Education concurs, effective with the Fall Semester 1990, room and apartment fees shall be established as shown in the addendum to this resolution, and be it
- RESOLVED, That, if the Board of Governors for Higher Education concurs, rental rates for rooms to be occupied during the summer session shall be prorated in accordance with the fee schedule shown in the addendum to this resolution, commencing with the Summer Session of 1990, and be it
- RESOLVED, That the Board of Trustees will review Housing Fees on an annual basis and will request changes, if necessary, before January 1 of each year.
