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RESOLUTION

concerning

AN INCREASE IN THE STATE UNIVERSITY STUDENT FEE FOR FULL-TIME STUDENTS

December 1, 1989

WHEREAS, Section 10a-99 of the General Statutes provides that the Board of Trustees for the Connecticut State University, subject to the approval of the Board of Governors for Higher Education, shall fix fees for such purposes as the Board of Trustees deems necessary, and

WHEREAS, Revenue produced at current rates is not sufficient to cover the long range facilities program for self-liquidating obligations, be it

RESOLVED, That Board Resolution #87-179 is hereby rescinded, and be it

RESOLVED, That State University Student Fee rates be increased from \$120 to \$145 per semester (\$290 per academic year) for residents of Connecticut, and from \$295 to \$356 per semester (\$712 per academic year) for nonresidents, to be effective with the Fall semester of 1990.
