WHEREAS, The Trustees of Connecticut State University recognize and encourage the development of mutually reciprocal and beneficial exchange and other academic relationships between its campuses and appropriate universities abroad, and

WHEREAS, The Trustees have recognized the International Affairs Center at Central Connecticut State University as the International Affairs Center for all campuses of Connecticut State University, and


WHEREAS, The Board of Governors for Higher Education has recognized the International Affairs Center as a Center for Excellence in the State of Connecticut to promote and establish mutually reciprocal and beneficial exchange and other academic relationships which will also benefit the people and institutions of the State of Connecticut, and

WHEREAS, The Trustees acknowledge that mutually reciprocal and beneficial exchange and other academic relationships developed under the auspices of the International Affairs Center often require the reciprocal waiving of certain usual and customary charges for part-time international students for one semester such as those for on-campus housing, part-time course fees charged for credit courses and the registration fee, excluding the mandatory insurance fee, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, Notwithstanding the provisions contained in BR#90-36, "Course Fees and Other Charges for Programs Operated in Conjunction with the International Affairs Center of Central Connecticut State University", the presidents of the campuses of Connecticut State University may waive course fees, registration fees, and room and board fees for one semester for part-time international students whose home university has, in the judgement of the campus president, provided services or waived fees of corresponding value for students and/or faculty of Connecticut State University, and be it

RESOLVED, That campus presidents shall report the number, value, and justifications for their exercise of this privilege to the President of Connecticut State University annually on July 1.

Subj: Resolution concerning Waiver of Fees for Part-Time International Students: Responses to your questions of 3/18/91

1. Are we waiving charges to part-time students only, or to conference attendees as well?

The purpose of the draft Resolution is to waive charges for part-time international students only; it is not to waive charges for conference attendees.

2. Is there a time consideration connected with the proposed waivers?

The requested waivers will be for the duration of the academic term for which the waiver is applied- i.e. up to one semester in length.

3. Are you expecting to hold rooms vacant to accommodate these individuals?

We expect to hold vacant a limited number of dorm rooms to accommodate these part-time international students but please bear in mind the required quid pro quo reciprocity in the fourth "Whereas" clause of the draft Resolution. In other words, we will hold vacant a limited number of rooms for international part-time students just as our international partner university will do for our students. We have, in fact, been doing this for years.

4. Are the part-time students to be enrolled in regular credit-bearing courses?

The part-time students are likely to be enrolled in regular credit-bearing courses, probably as auditors.

5. Since there is no part-time general fee. I presume you are referring to registration fees. Correct?

Yes, I am referring to course fees charged part-time students for credit courses and the registration fee also charged them.

6. Is the mandatory insurance fee included or waived? I assume it is included.

The mandatory insurance fee is neither included nor waived by the draft Resolution. We will require all part-time international students covered by this Resolution to pay the insurance fee themselves.
