ESTABLISHING A COOPERATIVE EDUCATION PROGRAM



- WHEREAS, Eastern Connecticut State University began a pilot program in Cooperative Education in 1986, with the approval of Eastern's President, the Curriculum Committee, and the University Senate, and
- WHEREAS, Eastern's Cooperative Education Program has developed beyond the pilot stage, and
- WHEREAS, Cooperative Education placements in Eastern's program are evaluated by the Cooperative Education staff to determine the learning experience involved in the placement, and
- WHEREAS, Students participating in the program generally work full time and receive pay for their cooperative education placement, and
- WHEREAS, Any academic credit awarded to a student will be as a result of an evaluation process and, at the discretion of, appropriate personnel within the student's academic discipline, and
- WHEREAS, Cooperative Education is basically a general fund program and, therefore, personal services, other expenses, and equipment costs will be sought in the general fund budget requests, and
- WHEREAS, It is necessary to obtain Board of Trustees approval and recognition of Eastern Connecticut State University's Cooperative Education Program to establish waiver and fee policies, and
- WHEREAS, Expectations are that adequate general fund support will provide for personal services, other expenses and equipment and to defray additional special costs such as, but not limited to conferences, workshops and awards, there will be a modest Cooperative Education fee charged to students, be it
- RESOLVED, That effective this date, Eastern Connecticut State University's Cooperative Education Program is officially recognized by the Board of Trustees of the Connecticut State University System.
