INCREASE IN STUDENT ACTIVITY FEE FOR FULL-TIME STUDENTS

January 10, 1992

WHEREAS, Section 10a-99 of the General Statutes provides that the Board of Trustees for the Connecticut State University, shall fix fees for such purposes as the Board of Trustees deems necessary, and

WHEREAS, The Student Government Association of Southern Connecticut State University has recommended an annual increase in the Student Activity Fee from \$42 to \$84 to meet the increase in costs of Student Government organizations and related student activities, and


WHEREAS, A detailed analysis of the Student Activity Fund indicates that an increase of \$22 would be sufficient to fund their activities, including club sports, be it
