TUITION AT THE CONNECTICUT STATE UNIVERSITY

May 1, 1992

WHEREAS, Anticipated General Fund Appropriations for 1992-93 fall far short of current services requirements, and

WHEREAS, Portions of this shortfall may be met through spending reductions and the transfer of some costs to the Tuition Fund, be it

RESOLVED, That Board Resolution #91-106 is repealed, and be it

RESOLVED, That the 1992-93 Tuition Fund spending plan be financed by drawing down the fund balance and by increasing, effective July 1, 1992, the rates per semester of Tuition charged to Connecticut State University students as follows;
