

- WHEREAS, The current F. R. Noble Laboratory School at Eastern Connecticut State University is being renovated into a modern, residence hall facility, and
- WHEREAS, Such facility will be open to students at the beginning of the Fall Semester, 1992, and
- WHEREAS, F. R. Noble served as Principal of Willimantic State Normal School from 1918 to 1937 and first President of Willimantic State Teachers College from 1937 to 1947, and
- WHEREAS, Dr. David G. Carter, President of Eastern Connecticut State University, has recommended that F. R. Noble continue to be the namesake for the building, therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, That effective this date, the F. R. Noble Laboratory School at Eastern Connecticut State University be hereby renamed the F. R. Noble Residence Hall.
