POLICY ON PAYMENT OF MOVING EXPENSES

June 11, 1993

WHEREAS, Since 1986, there has been no review of the Policy on Payment of Moving Expenses, and

WHEREAS, The Board's Personnel and Employee Relations Committee has reviewed moving policies of other higher educational institutions within Connecticut, and


WHEREAS, Revision of the existing policy is necessary, now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, On July 1, 1993, Board Resolution #86-60 is rescinded and the following policy shall take effect. The University President and campus Presidents are authorized to offer reimbursement for out-of-state moving expenses for prospective employees when, in the judgment of the president, such an offer would be in the best interests of Connecticut State University, and be it further

RESOLVED, The offer to pay moving expenses shall be in writing and shall not exceed \$4,000 for any one prospective employee, and be it further

RESOLVED, Such expenses shall be paid as a reimbursement for documented expenses and shall be assessed against the budget of the particular University or Connecticut State University Executive Office where the prospective employee will serve.
