
- WHEREAS, The Southern Connecticut State University soccer team is the 1995 champion of the National Collegiate Athletic Association Division II, and

- WHEREAS, The excellence of Southern's soccer team reflects the commitment to academic excellence that defines the University's mission as a whole, therefore be it




