CHANCELLOR'S RECOMMENDATION

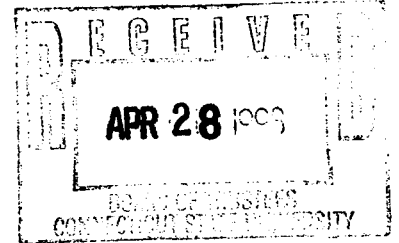
Accept the two gifts of \$10,000 and \$11,403 cash on behalf of Central Connecticut State University.
